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CROWNS OR BRIDGES

You have just had crowns or bridges cemented onto your teeth. They will replace your missing tooth/teeth very well, and should serve you well for years to come provided you follow these instructions:

Chewing: To obtain maximum strength of the cement, do not chew hard or sticky foods for 1 hour after your appointment.

Sensitivity: Mild sensitivity to hot or cold foods is common. This sensitivity will gradually disappear over a few weeks. If the sensitivity lasts longer than six weeks, please notify our office.

Preventive Procedures: To provide optimum longevity for your restorations, visit us at your regular 3, 4 or 6 month examination appointments. Often any problems that may develop can be found at an early stage and corrected easily. Failure to return for routine professional examinations is the most significant reason for restoration failure.

Problems: If any of the following conditions occur, please call our office.

- Movement or looseness in the restoration
- Sensitivity to sweet foods
- A peculiar taste from the restoration site
- Breakage of a piece of material from the restoration
- Sensitivity to pressure
